## Find your NYS Senator and Assembly Member:

- Download our Advocacy Packet to get prepared
- Send an email using our templates
- Set up a meeting to discuss legislation in NY
- Sign messages created by other organizations to show your support



**Build a District Report using the [data.nysed.edu](https://data.nysed.edu) site and include latest NAEP data**



## Reach out to Education Committee chairs

- Send email to Senate and Assembly chairs
- Arrange a meeting to discuss literacy legislation in NY
- Ask them to support current literacy bills



**Research and familiarize yourself with the latest [literacy bills](#) in the Senate & Assembly**



## Reach out to NYS Governor

- Call the Governor's office to sign applicable bills into law
- Write to the Governor and ask for her support of literacy legislation
- Join others and sign their messages calling on the Governor to sign bills



**Make sure to mention only bills that have been brought to the Governor for their signature**
